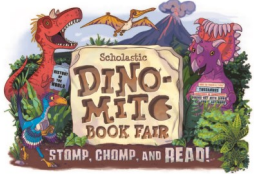
## Scholastic Book Fair

We are in need of volunteers to help as a cashier, assist during the week and help in breaking down on Friday, May 10th. Please click the link below to sign up to volunteer.

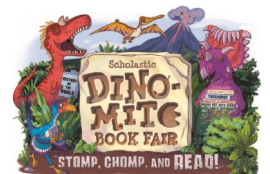
