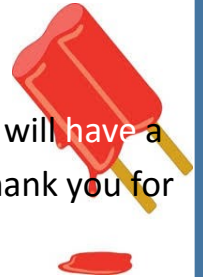

There will be contests and games daily for campers to practice and enhance their new found offensive habits. The camp will be staffed by the Oakmont Basketball Coaching Staff and players currently playing for Oakmont High School and campers will be grouped by skill level and grade.

CAMP DESCRIPTION

This camp will focus on developing the fundamental skills of ball handling, shooting, and finishing around the basket. Players will play on lowered rims and with youth sized basketball appropriate to the age level. The camp will be overseen by the Oakmont Basketball Coaching Staff and the players. Campers will be grouped by skill level and grade.

CAMP FACILITIES

The camp will be held at Oakmont High School in the Main Gyms **AND** possibly outdoor basketball courts.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Campers need to check in daily upon arrival at the check in table. The gym will be open at 8:30 a.m. for free shooting with supervision both weeks. The camp begins at 9 a.m. sharp every day, and ends at **11am for K-2nd graders** and **2:30pm for 3-7th graders**.

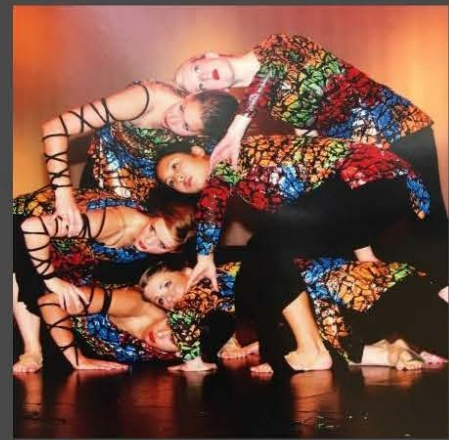

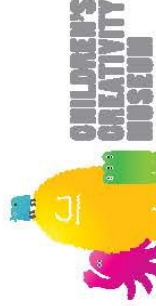

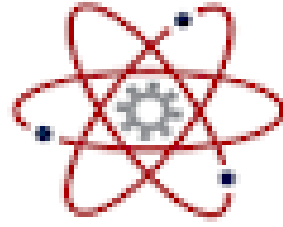
