Nant to attend the end of the year Field Trips?

RCSD policy states that in order to volunteer or attend any of the schools field trips, a volunteer must complete a TB test and get a Livescan finger print completed. The fingerprinting is valid for the Roseville City School District through 8th grade. If you have had a TB test completed in the past few years, we can use those results as the TB tests are good for 4 years through RCSD.

Once everything is competed and the application is returned to the Brown office, you are eligible to attend field trips and work in the classroom. The process could take approximately two weeks.



If you already have your access to the PowerSchool Parent Portal, but are experiencing technical difficulty, staff will be available to assist you.

Please note, to protect the privacy and safety of our student(s), we are unable to provide your Access ID and Passwords over the phone or via email. Parents will be required to show identification to complete the registration process.


