Reminders from the Office

Late for school:

Children who arrive at their classroom after the 8:10 a.m. start bell are tardy. They must report to the office for a tardy pass before going to class.

Messages to Students:

Valuable instructional minutes are lost for ALL children for every interruption in the class. Please call before lunch if you must leave a message for your child. ALL messages about homework, forgotten lunches, etc. will be e-mailed to the teacher. The office will interrupt the classroom only in an emergency.

Label, Label, Label:

Please label your child's lunch bag and clothing. There have been several issues with kids having the same lunch bag and students getting upset thinking someone had taken their lunch. Clothing that is labeled is less likely to disappear and will be returned.

Absences:

Brown needs to know the status of your child everyday to ensure their safety. Please remember to report an absence by 9:00am. For your convenience, you can call our 24 hour hotline at 916-771-1710, option 1. If absences are not verified, they will be considered unexcused.

Medication at School:

If your child needs to take medication during the school day, by law you MUST have a Parent/Physician Release for Medication in School form filled out and signed by BOTH you and the physician.

This applies to over-the-counter (e.g., Tylenol, Motrin, etc.), as well as prescription medications.
